- Infrastructure planning/nexus with the private sector: what are the resilient and equity lenses?
 - How is climate vulnerability defined and why is this relevant?
 - LA County’s approach to State and Federal infrastructure funds.
- Oil and gas industry transition: opportunities for sites and workers as they transition.
- Single use plastics ordinance.
- LA County’s plans regarding water resiliency and recycling projects (Measure W).
 - Public and business opportunities
- LA County Real Estate and moving towards net zero.
- Public Private Partnerships.
